Scholarships for International Students

UK Scholarship information is very hard to synthesize because it is scattered all over their websites and is fragmented by subject of study and nationality of student, etc.

- These are the scholarships that we know about for 2013 entry for which Pakistani students may apply.
- Do your research. Other universities may offer scholarship, and there may be other scholarships at listed universities. Scholarships on offer and details are subject to change each year.
- Please see the prospectus of each university for information about amounts, eligibility and application procedures.
- Scholarship opportunities may be different for UK/EU or other passport holders.

This list is a partial list and is not comprehensive.

Bournemouth University

- Undergraduate International Scholarships, normally of about £1,000/year.

Bristol, University of

- International Office Scholarships, 5 awards totalling £8,500 - £3,000 in years 1 and 2 and £2,500 in year 3.

Brunel University

- Brunel International Scholarship Program, 30 awards of 15% discount off tuition fees.
- International Alumni Scholarships, 7 awards of 15% discount off tuition fees.

Cambridge, University of

- 800th Anniversary Scholarships for Applicants from Pakistan: All courses except Medicine and Veterinary. Covers cost of tuition and college fees, includes grant towards maintenance and travel costs for each year of the course. Amount of maintenance takes financial circumstances into account. Application required.
- Colleges: Some colleges offer partial financial support for overseas students.
- Some awards offered through Cambridge Commonwealth and Overseas Trusts. Eligibility requirements vary. See website.

City University 2013

- Some schools and departments have scholarships that int'l students are eligible for.
 - Cass Business School
 - International Student Scholarship: £2,000/yr for 3 years. A*AA (one of which must be Bio, Chem., Eco, Math, Phys, Stats). A*A*A for Actuarial Science.
 - Coca Cola Scholars Scheme: 8 awards of full tuition fees plus a contribution to living expenses for 3 years. Criteria: Outstanding academic achievement, leadership quality, financial need. Apply by June 7.

East Anglia, University of

50th Anniversary Scholarships: value £6,150 - £7,450, depending on course

Herriot-Watt University (may not be exhaustive, check website):

- Engineering and Physical Sciences Overseas Scholarship Scheme: £2,000 for one year
- Life Sciences Overseas Scholarship Scheme: £1,250/year for up to 4 years.
- Mathematics – MACS Undergraduate Overseas Scholarship: Discount of application fees for those who “excel academically or have a financial circumstance which they feel

entitles them to a fee reduction.” Student may not have sponsorship – reduction is for families who are paying.

Kent, University of

- International Scholarships for Undergraduate students, £5000/year – requirement “The applicant must have demonstrated ability to fund their program of study.”
- School of Engineering - Flannigan Scholarships, £1,000 for the first year.
- School of Arts – International Undergraduate Scholarships £1,000 for the first year.

Leicester, University of

- Open Scholarships for Undergraduate Students: 15 awards of £2,500/year. Except medicine.
- Fee Discounts for International Students:
 - Family Loyalty Discount Scheme: 10% discount of course fees/year. For siblings, spouses, and children of international students or graduates of full time courses.

Liverpool, University of

- Vice Chancellor’s International Attainment Scholarship: £2,500/year renewable for the length of the programmed. Awarded automatically.
- Sport Liverpool Scholarship for talented athletes competing at the national/regional levels. Up to £2,000 to support performance. Application
- Liverpool Affinity Award” £500/year for children, siblings or spouses of current students or graduates. Application.

London School of Economics, U. of London

- LSE Undergraduate Support Scheme: amount of assistance will vary according to individual financial needs but are normally between £3,000 and £6,000, renewable
- School offers a limited number of scholarships of varying amounts for overseas students.

Southborough, University of

- Southborough University International Scholarship: 25% of tuition fees. Self funded international undergraduate applicants automatically considered

Newcastle University

Newcastle University offers a large number of partial scholarships to international students. Many of the schools offer partial scholarships and bursaries.

- International Undergraduate Merit Scholarships (IUMS): £2,000 for the first year.
- International Family Discounts (IFD): 10% discount on tuition fees per year renewable for parent/child/spouse or U Newcastle students or graduates.
- Civil Eng and Geosciences Int’l Undergraduate Scholarship: £1,000 or £2,000 renewable for up to 4 years.
- Electrical and Electronic Eng. Overseas Scholarships: £3,000/year
- School of Biomedical Sciences Intl Students Scholarships: up to £3,000 (£1,000/yr) For students who apply to be an international ambassador.

Nottingham, University of

- Family Scholarship: 10% discount on first year’s tuition fee available for students with family (parents, siblings, spouses) who are graduates of or students at the University of Nottingham (UK, Malaysia and China).

Oxford University

- Reach Oxford Scholarships: university fee, college fee and full living expenses plus one trip home a year. “Applicants from low income countries who cannot study in their own countries.” All subjects except medicine. Application required.

Queen Mary and Westfield, U. of London

- International Science and Engineering Excellence Awards: £2,000 and £5,000/year. Automatic consideration.
- International Mathematical Sciences Excellence Awards £2,250, renewable. Automatic.

Queens University Belfast

- Biomedical Science Scholarship: £1,500/year. Automatic consideration.
- Family Scholarship: 10% of tuition fee for sibling, parent of child of a current or past international student. Application required.
- Geography, Archaeology and Palaeoecology Scholarship: £1,500 one time
- Psychology Scholarship £1,500/ year. Automatic consideration.
- New Opportunities Scholarship: £1,500 one time Available for a limited number of courses. Application required.

Royal Holloway University, U. of London

- International Excellence Scholarships; 6 awards of £10,000 one time. Application req.
- Biosciences Entrance Scholarships: up to 5 awards of £1,000 one time.
- Student Talented Athlete Recognition Scheme: up to 25 awards of £1,000/yr. Student must have an outstanding ability in a particular sport, being currently junior or senior international performers, or showing strong evidence of international potential.

Sheffield, University of

- Engineering International Scholarships: £2,000/yr renewable. Automatic consideration.
- Science International Scholarships: £2,000/yr renewable. Automatic consideration.
- Law International Scholarships: £1,500/yr renewable. Automatic consideration.
- Arts International Scholarships: £1,500/yr renewable. Automatic consideration.
- Management International Scholarship: £1,500/yr renewable. Automatic consideration.
- Social Science International Scholarship: £1,500/yr renewable. Automatic consideration.
- Pakistan Merit Undergraduate Scholarships: 2 awards of £7,000/yr renewable. All programs except Medicine and Dentistry. Application required.

Southampton, University of

- Biological Science bursaries: £1,000 onetime payment for each A-level at Grade A, maximum£3,000.
- Physics and Astronomy scholarships: £1,000 each year for every grade A achieved in A level examinations (up to a maximum of £3,000 per year).
- Psychology International Scholarship: £2,500 per year renewable. Automatic consideration
- Art: £1,000 in the first year only.

Sussex, University of

- Chancellor’s International Scholarships: up to 40 merit scholarships to new international students.

University College London, U. of London

- Denys Holland Undergraduate scholarship: £9,000/year for a maximum of 3 years. For those with financial need.

West of England, University of the

- Academic Merit Scholarship: Up to £1,500 to overseas students

West of Scotland, University of the (formerly University of Paisley and Bell College)

- International Scholarship: £1,500 award. Automatic consideration.
- Accommodation Bursary: £1,000 deducted from cost of accommodation.
- Discounts for early payment of tuition and accommodation fees. See website.
- International Undergraduate Scholarships: 25% fee reduction upon entry into year one. Further 10% discount for fees paid in full within one week of start of classes.

York University

- Scholarship for Overseas Students: 1/3 or 1/6 of overseas tuition fee for each year of successful study, except programmes at Hull York Medical School.

The Bestway Foundation provides scholarships and grants for students of Pakistani, Indian, Sri Lankan & Bangladeshi origin both in the UK as well as overseas. Applications for Bestway Foundation scholarships are considered for **tuition fee support only**. The next round of applications would now be considered in January 2015.
